UW DEPARTMENT OF PEDIATRICS PEER CLINICAL EVALUATION INSTRUCTIONS

OBJECTIVE

To gain insight from your colleagues into your clinical acumen, communication skills, and professionalism.

GENERAL

Fifteen (15) peer clinical evaluations are required for the reappointment/promotion packets for the following:

- 2nd Term Reappointment of:
 - Clinician-Scholars
 - Faculty-Scientists
- Promotion of:
 - Academic Clinicians

New peer clinical evaluations must be obtained for each reappointment and promotion step as above.

All aspects of the candidate's clinical work (inpatient, outpatient, consultation) should be evaluated.

Only physicians can provide a peer clinical evaluation. Nurse practitioners, nurses, physician assistants, and other non-MD medical professionals are not eligible.

The following are eligible to be an evaluator:

- Physicians regardless of academic rank. Residents and fellows are not eligible.
- Physicians within and outside the candidate's division.
- Physicians with whom the candidate has had contact since his/her last appointment or promotion.
- Physicians previously at UW/Seattle Children's/FHCRC who left within the last three years.

DIVISION HEAD

Select (with input from the candidate) **15-20** physicians who will be asked to complete the peer clinical evaluation and provide the list to the Division Administrative Staff for population.

DIVISION ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF

Submit to <u>UWPedsFA@seattlechildrens.org</u> the list of all evaluators using the "Promotion Contact List" no later than the requested date.

FACULTY AFFAIRS TEAM

The Faculty Affairs Team will issue an electronic version of the peer clinical evaluation to each evaluator using REDCap and will track evaluator progress to completion.
