

How To Configure Husky OnNet for Pediatrics Users

If you have not already downloaded and installed the Husky OnNet (F5 Big-IP VPN Client) follow instructions here: <https://itconnect.uw.edu/connect/uw-networks/about-husky-onnet/use-husky-onnet/#download>

Adding Pediatrics Husky OnNet VPN server addresses to the F5 Big-IP VPN Client

To access Pediatrics network folders (i.e. Pedshare, Pedsecure, User home folders), you need to configure the Pediatrics Husky OnNet server address.

MacOS

1. From the Server pull down menu, click **Add New Server**.
2. Enter the appropriate address for the desired server:
 - UW Campus Network Traffic Only: **https://dept-huskyonnet.uw.edu/peds**
3. Press **Return**. This will perform a server verification step. (**Note**: do not select the Verify option as this will cause the system to hang.)
4. Click **Add and Connect**. This adds the server address as the new server in your server list and takes you to the authentication login screen.
5. Log in and let the system connect. The system should repopulate the original server name(s) into the server pulldown menu list.

Windows

1. On the main console, click **Change Server**.
2. Select and clear out the current server.
3. Enter the appropriate address for the missing server:
 - UW Campus Network Traffic Only: **https://dept-huskyonnet.uw.edu/peds**
4. To add the server address as the new server in the list, click Next. To confirm, click Change Server again. You should see the server name in the server pulldown menu list.
5. To access the server, select it and click **Connect**.
